On Sunday August 27th at 3:30 PM we will be having the vote of our Central Methodist Church members in the presence of our new DS that will be the next to last disaffiliation step. The conference requires a 2/3 vote of the congregation affirming that we indeed wish to disaffiliate before our disaffiliation can be approved by a vote of the conference on November 4th. The work on achieving this goal for our congregation began almost 2 years ago and has involved a lot of dedicated effort on the part of the church leadership team following the mandate by 94% of those attending the informational Town Hall meetings. PLEASE PLAN TO BE PRESENT ON AUGUST 27th FOR THE OFFICIAL VOTE OF THE PROFESSING MEMBERS OF OUR CONGREGATION.

Dear Central Church Member,

On behalf of the Discernment Committee and the Church Council, we want to notify you of the approaching called Church Conference meeting in the Family Life Center on Sunday, August 27th at 3:30 pm, where you will formally vote on the decision to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church. The Church Conference has been called and authorized by the Rev. Beth Crissman, our District Superintendent. Rev. Crissman will lead the Church Conference and preside over our disaffiliation vote, as the Annual Conference requires.

Even though 94% of our congregation voted last summer after the 2nd Town Hall meeting to support the pursuit of disaffiliation, the only means recognized by our Conference to disaffiliate is to have a formal vote at a called Church Conference.

There must be a 2/3 majority "YES" vote of Professing Members present at the Church Conference to be able to continue the process to disaffiliate, allowing us more independence in decision making for our church body, and to gain control of our church property, which is now held in "Trust" by the conference. Even though your leadership group had more substantive concerns than those listed in the Church Disaffiliation Resolution (see below this letter), this is the resolution that has been agreed upon by the conference and your church leadership.

Please note: There are three voting options at this Church Conference: "Yes" (to disaffiliate), "No" (not to disaffiliate), and "Abstain." Any vote at the Church Conference on August 27 other than "Yes" will be counted as a "No" vote -including a vote to "Abstain"-when it comes to achieving the required 2/3 majority needed for disaffiliation.

Please be in prayer about this important Church Conference, and plan to be present on August 27th (at 3:30 pm) to cast your vote that will determine the life and future of your church.

## Anticipated Resolution and Ballot Form Sample

#### **CENTRAL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH** Resolution to

#### **Disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church**

**Whereas,** the congregation of has become increasingly uncomfortable with the direction of The United Methodist Church regarding their departure from strict adherence to the Book of Discipline regarding matters that the Bible defines clearly specifically regarding human sexuality and marriage as well as the actions and inactions of the Western North Carolina Conference in response to this departure;

And Whereas, CENTRAL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH believes in the inerrancy of Scripture and that the Bible is profitable for "doctrine, for reproof, for correction, and for instruction in righteousness." Unfortunately, The United Methodist Church has departed from these truths, and by the actions and inactions of the Western North Carolina Conference, this departure has been supported by the conference.

And Whereas, CENTRAL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH does not agree with the changes in the United Methodist denominational position on gender which is clearly defined in Scripture as one's gender determined at birth and that the rejection of one's biological gender. Any departure is a rejection of God's decreed will and his good plan for humanity and the individual. Additionally, marriage is clearly defined in Scripture as between one man and one woman ordained by God through holy matrimony. Any perversion of this sacred union goes against the Word of God.

And Whereas, the General Conference provides for a disaffiliation process for congregations;

**Therefore,** be it resolved that the CENTRAL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, with a more than two thirds vote of members at special called church conference has voted to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church and;

**Be it resolved** that Board of Trustees and Leadership team are given the authority to negotiate and enter into a formal disaffiliation agreement with the Conference Trustees and execute all deeds, contracts, instruments, etc. needed to carry it out and

**Be it resolved** that said formal disaffiliation agreement will be placed on the agenda of the special called November 2023 meeting of the Western North Carolina Annual Conference and ask that the conference respect and affirm the desire of the CENTRAL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH congregation to disaffiliate from The United Methodist Church.

Do you vote to support the above resolutions so that **CENTRAL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH** will petition for Disaffiliation at the 2023 Annual Conference?

Dear Church family,

I wanted to let you know about what the Lord is setting in motion for me this year. As some of you may remember from Senior Sunday a few weeks ago, I recently graduated from high school and from RCC with my Associate in Arts. This year I am taking a break from my studies to focus on my relationship with God before continuing my education. In about a week, I will leave for a week-long mission trip to Honduras, and in September I will be heading to the Youth With A Mission {VWAM} base in Alesund, Norway for a discipleship training school. I will spend three months there in the lecture phase of the program with the outreach portion of that program for the two months immediately following. I am so excited to see the Lord move in my life this year and see where He takes me after. I would love to go into this with your support and there are two big ways you could help me out.

First, while this is an exciting opportunity for me it is also nerve-wracking. I signed up for this knowing it would include a lot of firsts for me as well as a lot of unknowns. This September will be my first time flying alone; this will be my first time living for an extended amount of time in a country where I don't know anyone; and for the outreach phase of the program, I won't know where I will be sent until late November/early December. With that being said, I would love to go into this knowing I have an army of prayer warriors behind me. If you feel so called to support me in this way, please add your name and contact information to the signup sheet so I will know who to reach out to with updates and prayer requests. If you feel led to support me financially, I would greatly appreciate that as well. Overall, my goal is to try and raise about \$8,655. This will break down into roughly \$2,800 for the lecture phase, \$3,200 for the outreach phase, \$2,375 for my plane ticket, and \$280 for my travel/medical insurance. Checks can be made payable to Central UMC with my name on the memo line and mailed in the envelopes provided. Any money that I receive that exceeds the amount I need for the trip will go toward our church's mission fund.

Thank you in advance for supporting me in this new venture through your prayers and/or financial support.




