Read the Bible passage for each of the next 30 days and answer the following three questions about the daily text:

- I) Observation—"What does it say?"
- 2) Interpretation—"What does it mean?"
- 3) Application—"What do I do?"

___Day I: Ezra 7:10

¹⁰ For Ezra had set his heart to study the Law of the Lord, and to do it and to teach his statutes and rules in Israel.

__Day 2: Acts 17:11

"Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.

_Day 3: Joshua I:8

⁸This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

__Day 4: Psalm II9:15-16

¹⁵ I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways. ¹⁶ I will delight in your statutes; I will not forget your word.

__Day 5: 2 Timothy 3:14-17

¹⁴ But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it ¹⁵ and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. ¹⁶ All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,¹⁷ that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

__Day 6: James I:22-25

²² But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³ For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. ²⁴ For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. ²⁵ But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing.

__Day 7: Psalm II9:II-I2

"I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you. ¹² Blessed are you, O Lord; teach me your statutes!

_Day 8: Psalm 119:9-10

- ⁹ How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word.
- ¹⁰ With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your commandments!

Day 9: Luke II:28 ²⁸ But he said, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and keep it!"
Day I0: Psalm II9:105 105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.
Day II: Proverbs 4:10-13 10 Hear, my son, and accept my words, that the years of your life may be many. "I have taught you the way of wisdom; I have led you in the paths of uprightness. 12 When you walk, your step will not be hampered, and if you run, you will not stumble. 13 Keep hold of instruction; do not let go; guard her, for she is your life.
Day I2: Revelation I:3 ³ Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near.
Day I3: Matthew 7:24 ²⁴ "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock.
Day I4: Romans I5:4 ⁴ For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.
Day 15: Psalm II9:18 ¹⁸ Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law.
Day I6: John 8:31-32 ³¹ So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, ³² and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
Day I7: Isaiah 55:II "So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it
Day 18: Psalm 119:130 The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.
Day I9: Romans I2:2 ² Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.
Day 20: Matthew 4:4 ⁴ But [Jesus] answered, "It is written, "'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

____**Day 21: Romans 10:17**¹⁷ So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.

___Day 22: John 6:63

⁹⁷Oh how I love your law! It is my meditation all the day. ⁹⁸Your commandment makes me wiser than my enemies, for it is ever with me.

¹⁷ If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.

___Day 25: Colossians 3:16

¹⁶ Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

__Day 26: Psalm 19:7-8

⁷The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple; ⁸the precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes.

___Day 27: Psalm I:I-3

¹Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; ² but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night. ³ He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers.

___Day 28: 2 Timothy 2:15

¹⁵ Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.

___Day 29: Hebrews I:I-2

¹Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, ²but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.

___Day 30: 2 Peter 3:18

¹⁸ But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.
